



This month's question answered by:

Q: I tied for first in low net for my flight in the last tournament, but then "lost in a card-off." What does that mean and how does that work?

A: We break ties with a method recommended by the USGA. One or more steps is followed until a winner is produced. Step 1 is to compare net scores for the final 9 holes (i.e. the Back Nine of the course) and if there is a winner we're done. If not, Step 2 is to compare net scores over the final 6 holes of the Back Nine. Again, if still tied, Step 3 is to compare the final 3 holes of the Back Nine. If STILL tied, Step 4 is to compare 18th hole scores. Step 5, if needed, is a coin flip.

Similar card-offs can be done for ties for 2nd or 3rd place too. Sadly, if you lose a card-off for 3rd place, you likely win no money, you just have the satisfaction of having played fairly well.

One nice feature of this card-off method is that it rewards the player who plays better toward the end of play.
